

# LCA Fireworks Policy

## Policy (5.9)

1. It is against the law to set off fireworks in the County of Lac Ste. Anne without a permit.
2. The use of High Hazard (or Display) Fireworks at the Camp is strictly prohibited.
3. The use of Low Hazard Fireworks at the Camp is also prohibited unless ALL of the following conditions are met:
  - 3.1 A written request must be submitted to the Board by the interested party, and written approval from the Board granted. The Board reserves the right to reject, in its sole and unfettered discretion, any such request.
  - 3.2 If the Board approves the request, a fire permit must be obtained from the County of Lac Ste. Anne by the party who in-tends to set off the fireworks. A copy of this permit must be provided by the party to the Board prior to the event.
  - 3.3 The Board must notify the Association's insurance company of the fireworks event.
  - 3.4 The Fire Guardian must come out and inspect the location prior to the event. Note: The only location where fireworks will be permitted at camp (if they are permitted at all) is in the sand of the beach at the Point.
  - 3.5 A notice must be sent out so that members who have water-craft that are moored at the Point can move their watercraft out of the area if desired.
  - 3.6 The Board must arrange for the Firetruck or Fire Trailer to be present on site at the Point for the duration of the event.
  - 3.7 As the above steps understandably take some time to complete, it is advisable to submit the written request to the board well in advance of the proposed date of the event.
